APPLICATION and TESTING INSTRUCTIONS

Minimum requirements to apply:

- 21-34 years of age OR 20 years of age and who have successfully completed 2 years of law enforcement studies at an accredited college or university may be considered OR as otherwise exempt from age limitation by Illinois State Statute
- No felony or misdemeanor convictions involving moral turpitude
- Associates degree **OR** 60 semester college hours **OR** 90 quarter accredited college hours **OR** 2 years U.S. military service with honorable discharge and a high school diploma
- U.S. citizenship or legal alien admitted for residence (green card holder)
- Candidates must possess a valid driver's license
- Residency within 20 miles of the Village of Glendale Heights by end of 18 month period of probation
- **No fee to apply** (Study guides will be provided at the time of application submission. Written examination questions are based on information provided in the study guide.)
- Bi-lingual capability is desired but not required
- Not classified as a conscientious objector by Local Selective Service Draft Board
- Salary range: Starting \$68,203 Ceiling \$102,440 (after 7 years of service)
